All divisions will be ridden together in the same class however each division (Junior, Adult Amateur and Open) may be pinned separately - 1st through 6th place ribbon in each class.

One Horse/Rider Combination per entry. Additional horses or riders require separate entry form.

Sand competition and warm up arenas. Water is available, but can be a distance away. May be advisable to bring your own water.

Riders are eligible as Juniors from the beginning of the calendar year until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 18.

All riders must wear properly fastened ASTM approved protective headgear at all times while mounted.

Any person (Junior or Senior) who gives riding instruction, and/or receives compensation for riding or training, is considered a professional and, as such, is ONLY eligible for Open divisions.

The show management reserves the right to vary or change show officials or judges, to decline any entry, and cancel, divide or combine classes. No refunds after closing date.

For any class noted as TOC, you must specify the Level and Test number. (e.g. 3rd Level Test 3).

Exhibitors are encouraged to leave their dogs at home. Any dog brought to the show grounds must remain leashed at all times.
