What are the Starter (S) & Elementary cross-country courses like?

- Elementary (E) takes place out on the cross country course but has no water and is primarily made up of logs with perhaps 1-2 other jump types. Elementary consists of 7-10 jumping efforts of 2' or less.
- Starter (S) has a track similar to Beginner Novice (BN) but water is an option (BN usually has a flagged water but not always) and jumps are smaller. AE consists of 7-10 jumping efforts including logs and other jumps including coops and roll tops, all 2'3" or less.

Rules for the Day:

- Classes filled on first-come, first-served basis, in postmark order beginning with receipt.
- Provisional start times will be posted and emailed a minimum of 2 days prior to each start date.
- All horses must have proof of 12-month negative coggins (may be on file).
- All riders must wear a certified helmet with attached chinstrap at all times when mounted on the property
- All classes run generally under USEF/USDF/USEA rules for dressage and eventing.
- "Clinic Attire" acceptable (neat and tidy)
- Management reserves the right to refuse any entry for any reason
- Competition will take place rain or shine. No rain date, no refunds.
- A Late fee of \$40 will apply to all entries received after closing date. Change fee after closing date \$25.
- Refunds before closing date less \$25 office fee.

9. AMATEUR RIDER DECLARATION (AGE 19 AND OLDER)

AMATEUR STATUS: For all returning USEA members, Amateur status will be automatically transferred each year. It is the responsibility of each competitor to inform the USEA of any changes to their status. The benefits of amateur status are not retroactive. Amateur status begins at the time it is declared to the end of the current competition season. A fine of \$50.00 will be assessed for all Amateur exemption petitions to the USEA.

PLEASE READ – USEF DEFINITION OF AMATEUR STATUS

USEF Rules for Eventing Appendix 3, Section 4.4: AMATEUR RIDER (AR) - The following may participate in Eventing competitions as an Amateur. A) Any competitor in possession of a valid Amateur Card issued by the USEF, or B) Any Senior USEA member who competes in the Training, Novice or Beginner Novice level who meets the requirements of Federation GR1306. Individuals declaring such status must present, upon demand, an audited financial statement in support of the claim of eligibility; failure to do so will be deemed a violation. Misrepresentation of eligibility under this provision will subject an individual to disciplinary action under GR1307.6, GR1307.8, GR1308.3 and Chapter 6. Amateur certification under this provision is valid for Eventing competitions only and does not confer Amateur status for participation in any other Breed or Discipline. I hereby declare that I am NOT professional, but I am eligible for Amateur status under the conditions set forth in the above USEF rule.
